

“Walk-and talk”

Setting: The school’s nearby surroundings.

Instructions: Conversation topics during walk and talk activity, pair work (for topics see below). The topics were written on laminated sheets that the students would bring with them when walking (see below). Students are in small groups, preferably in pairs, and they are given several laminated sheets of different discussion topics (hence different colours). They are given time prior to the walk to sit in their groups and decide which topics they want to discuss on their walk because some preparation would make the discussion flow more easily.
